Compared to last week's market, both the feeder steer and heifer weight class price averages from 500 lbs and down ended fully firm while the weight classes over 500 lbs price averages weakened from \$2 to \$4. Slaughter cows finished mostly steady while the slaughter bulls ended \$2 stronger.

Demand continues to remain strong but there is a market undertone as the placement pattern for grazing cattle continues to alter due to the dry conditions developing in the West. Weather continues to dictate the feeder calf movement as both the Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles remain extremely dry forcing pre-mature movement into the feedlots.
