Compared to last week's market, feeder steers and heifers weight price averages ended fully steady. The market did show some undertone to the lighter weights on heifers but buyers still were active and aggressive on all classes. Slaughter cows finished around \$3 stronger with the slaughter bulls about \$5 better.

Even with the unrest in Europe creating financial market pressures, the stronger pressure point on prices will continue to be the lack of moisture in the plains. Continuing lack of moisture in the summer grazing regions along with lack of moisture in the corn belt can stifle planting and create higher gain costs.
