



Competition Terms and Conditions



1. The FIS #iBuiltThis2018 competition is free to enter. The competition is open to all residents of England, Scotland and Wales except for employees of the FIS and their close relatives and/or anyone connected to any FIS employee or to the competition.
2. Entrants under the age of 18 must have their parents/legal guardians tick the competition tick box, giving consent before entering the competition. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of the terms and conditions and our children and vulnerable persons image consent form and will bind the entrant and any parent or guardian who gives their consent to enter. The Promoter reserves the right to require entrants aged under 18 to provide proof of parental/guardian consent at any time. Failure to do so may result in the entrant being immediately disqualified from the competition.
3. There are three age categories, each having a different project theme as follows:
 - 13 years and under. Get creative with construction through play theme.
 - 14 to 18 years old. Schools, colleges or independent related projects theme.
 - 19 years and over. Projects undertaken by those in the industry and new entrants theme.
4. Entries to the competition must be done via the competition platform, submit their name, email address, upload image of entry and answer the age specific question, between 03 September 2018 and 23 September 2018. No entries will be accepted after this date.
5. You must not upload images which capture any image of another person (other than your child/ward/dependant) or sensitive information, such as yours or another person's private data.
6. The Promoter does not accept responsibility for any entries that are late, lost, incomplete, rendered illegible or for any network, computer, hardware or software failures of any kind, which may restrict or delay the sending or receipt of your entry.
7. The Promoter may, at its absolute discretion, refuse to accept any entry that is deemed to be incomplete, rendered illegible, offensive, automated, plagiarised and entries submitted on behalf of third parties will be disqualified.
8. There are three prizes to be won, one for each category, which are as follows:
 - 13 years and under category. Two day entry to the Lego Land Windsor resort and overnight accommodation at the Lego Land Castle Hotel. Prize is based on a family of four.
 - 14 to 18 year old category. An iPhone X device for a single individual.

9. The public voting period opens on the 24 September until 12 noon Sunday 30 September 2018. An individual can vote for their favourite entry in each category by entering the vote page, select their preferred image from the gallery and press the vote button to submit their vote.
10. The casting of votes by an individual is limited to one vote per age category per day, during the voting period. The maximum number of votes which can be cast by an individual is seven per age category.
11. Three entries in each category will be shortlisted based on the highest number of public votes cast against all valid entries. The short list of finalists will be published on the 01 October 2018.
12. From the shortlist, the judging panel will decide the winners from each age range. Their decision will be based solely on the criteria set and is final. No correspondence will be entered into. The criteria are as follows:
Best image based on brief and response to the age specific questions in each of the three categories.
13. The finalists and winners will be announced live at UK Construction Week 2018 on Tuesday 09 October, and winners will be notified of their success by the 19 October 2018 by email.
14. Winners will have one month to claim their prize. If prizes are not claimed within this time, the winner will be deemed to have forfeited the prize and the Promoter reserves the right to award the prize to another finalist in that category.
15. Once claimed, the prize will be sent to the winner by post by 05 November 2018. Prizes will only be sent to a valid UK postal address.
16. The names and entry images of the winners will be published on the Promoter's website by the 15 October 2018.
