

**“50 in 50”
Terms and Conditions**

By entering the “50 in 50” (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. STANDARD TERMS

1.1 Instructions on how to enter, prize details and other information contained within the promotional advertisements form part of these terms and conditions. By participating, in this promotion entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Western Australia aged 18 years of age or older, Photo identification may be required upon collection of the prize.

2.2 Employees (and their immediate families) of Seven Network (Operations) Limited, West Australian Newspapers and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.

3. HOW TO ENTER

3.1 The Competition commences on **Friday, October 26 at 10.00am AWST** and concludes on **Monday, November 5 at 10.00am AWST** (“Competition Period”).

3.2 In order to enter the draw, readers must register the daily code word online at thewest.com.au/win between October 26 and November 5. All entry fields must be completed and have the correct code word to be considered a valid entry.

3.3 A code word will be published in promotional advertising in The West Australian (M-F) October 26 to November 5. The code word is required to enter.

3.4 All entrants in the Competition may only enter once using the code word. All entrants found to have entered more than once will have their subsequent entries disqualified.

3.6 Entries must be received by **Monday, November 5 at 10.00am AWST**

3.7 The Promoters are not responsible for any data or other information related to this competition that may be lost, damaged as a result of any computer software or hardware malfunction. Any issues occurring as a result of computer / server/ software problems will be rectified as quickly as possible.

3.8 If any entries are deemed at the Promoter’s final discretion to be made via “scripting”, those entries will be deemed invalid and will not be accepted.

4. PRIZES

4.1 There will be **one (1)** prize winner who will receive the prize package detailed in clause 4.2.

Total maximum value prize package value is **\$7,500**.

4.3 In accepting the Prize Package, the winner and their nominated companions must abide by the following conditions:

a) The prize package must be taken as stated. No compensation will be payable if the winner is unable to use the Prize or any element of the Prize as stated.

b) In the event that a restaurant on the list goes into administration, the \$150 credit for that restaurant will be considered as forfeited and no cash alternative offer will be granted in lieu of the

c) The \$150 credit is allocated per restaurant. If the total amount of the final bill is less than this amount then no monies will be returned. The winner is responsible for paying amounts above \$150.

d) Valid for food and beverage to the value of \$150.

f) Bookings must be made in advance and are subject to seat availability. Bookings are to be made with a representative from the WA Good Food Guide, who will facilitate with the nominated restaurant and confirm the booking accordingly. Details of a contact person will be provided to the winner.

g) Credit is not valid on special events days (e.g Valentine's Day, Christmas Day and public holidays)

h) In the event that the winner wishes to redeem credit at two individual restaurants in one Monday to Thursday block, a request must be made to the WA Good Food Guide representative. It is at the discretion of the representative to accept the request.

- 4.4 The Prize winner and their nominated companions must participate in and co-operate with all reasonable media editorial requests, including but not limited to, being interviewed and photographed, and the Winners grant the Promoter a perpetual and non-exclusive licence to use such footage and photographs in all media worldwide and the Winners will not be entitled to any fee for such use.

5. HOW TO WIN

- 5.1 There will be **one (1)** prize winner randomly drawn from all valid entries. - 5.2 A member of the Seven West Media (WA) Marketing department will contact the prize winner by a phone call within two business days of the draw and a letter advising the prize winner of their prize will also be emailed to the email address on the entry.
- 5.3 The Promoter's decision is final and the Promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the result.
- 5.4 The Promoter may in its absolute discretion deem entries invalid subsequently to a prize winner being notified or a prize winner's name being announced if it is discovered that the prize winner did not enter the Competition in accordance with these terms and conditions. In these circumstances, an additional draw will be conducted.
