Conditions of Entry

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements form part of the Conditions of Entry of The Sunday Times TimesPool ("TimesPool"). By participating in the TimesPool, each participant fully and unconditionally agrees and acknowledges that these Conditions of Entry and the decision of The Sunday Times on all matters relating to the TimesPool are final and binding. The Promoter is The Sunday Times. A West Australian Newspapers Limited publication. ABN 98 008 667 632
2. For an entry coupon to be valid entrants must mark a cross in ink over their chosen six Jackpot letters and the Super Seven Bonus Letter on the alphabet grid provided on the coupon. If additional letters are crossed then the entry will be deemed invalid.
3. The TimesPool Jackpot letters selected are to be written in alphabetical order on the coupon and entries which do not fulfil this condition are invalid.
4. If the entry coupon is enclosed in an envelope, you must write your first (alphabetical order) Jackpot letter on the back of the envelope. Entries which do not fulfil this condition are invalid.
5. If submitting multiple entries enclosed in a single envelope, do not write the first alphabetically ordered Jackpot letter on the back of the envelope, instead write the words 'MULTIPLE ENTRIES'. Entries that do not fulfil this condition are invalid.
6. Only original entry coupons published in the hard copy (not digital pdf) of The Sunday Times are valid. Photocopies, scanned copies via email, printed copies of the coupon appearing in the pdf of the newspaper and facsimiles are not acceptable. Entry is open to residents of Western Australia only. **A valid entry consists of all required details and signature filled out by the entrant.**
7. Entries close 10am each Friday following publication of the coupon in the preceding edition of The Sunday Times. Entries lodged in TimesPool boxes at newsagencies must be received by 4pm each Wednesday following publication of the coupon.
8. Entrants must be over the age of 18 to enter TimesPool.
9. An entrant correctly selecting the six winning Jackpot letters will collect the weekly TimesPool Jackpot. If more than one entry has the six winning Jackpot letters, the weekly Jackpot will be shared equally among all winners.
10. If there is no winner with the six correct Jackpot letters, TimesPool will Jackpot by \$2,000 each week.

11. The Super Seven \$50,000 Bonus remains the same value every week and does not Jackpot.
12. Person(s) correctly selecting the six winning letters who have The Sunday Times home delivered will win an additional \$2,000.
13. If any jackpot or bonus is won by more than one person, that jackpot or bonus will be divided equally between all those who qualified to win that jackpot or bonus payment. For clarification, winners who do not have home delivery will share in the weekly Jackpot only and will not share in the home delivery bonus.
14. Person(s) who have The Sunday Times home delivered and correctly select the six winning TimesPool Jackpot letters will win an additional \$2000 or \$10,000 if they also select the Super Seven letter.
15. If the weekly Jackpot and Super Seven Bonus is won by more than one home delivery customer, the total prize pool consisting of the weekly Jackpot, Super Seven Bonus and the \$10,000 home delivery bonus will be divided equally between all home delivery customers. Winners who do not have home delivery will share in the weekly Jackpot and Super Seven Bonus but will not share in the \$10,000 home delivery bonus.
16. Person(s) have a chance to win an additional \$5,000 by collecting the PerthNow Bonus Word by logging onto www.perthnow.com.au and following the TimesPool links. The Bonus Word will change on a weekly basis and must correspond with the appropriate Game Number on the coupon in The Sunday Times.
17. The PerthNow Bonus Word must be included on the TimesPool coupon bearing the same game number from The Sunday Times in the space provided. To win the \$5000 for the PerthNow Bonus Word, person(s) must correctly select the six winning TimesPool Jackpot letters and the Super Seven Bonus letter.
18. The TimesPool Jackpot letters and the Super Seven Bonus letter will be drawn electronically each Friday after 10 am, subject to clause 19. The electronic draw is via a random number generator computer programme and will take place at The Sunday Times. The winning Jackpot letters and the Super Seven Bonus letter will be published in The Sunday Times the following Sunday.
19. The Sunday Times reserves the right to change the date of the draw for any particular entry week where the draw would otherwise have occurred on a public holiday or during the Christmas and New Year period. Where this occurs, The Sunday Times will publish the intended draw date in the newspaper with the relevant coupon.

20. The Promoter reserves the right to amend the total prize pool value if post announcement or publication (or both) of a jackpot amount, a valid winner is determined. In such an instance the total prize pool as advertised may revert to the original amount, or other amount as determined by the Promoter in their sole discretion.
21. Prize money will be made available one week after the publication date of the winning letters.
22. Prize money will be presented to winners in the form of a cheque.
23. Prize winners must present at Newspaper House, 50 Hasler Road, Osborne Park to collect their cheque. The cost of travel to the Sunday Times is at the winner's expense.

25. The Sunday Times will allow a period of one week for prize claims following the publication of the winning draw letters. Any claims, excluding the notified winners, should be made in writing within 5 working days of the draw publication. No re-check or search of eligible entries will be conducted except upon receipt of a written request accompanied by a written undertaking by the applicant to pay the costs of doing so if the re-check or search does not disclose a winning entry.

The TimesPool Jackpot amount will not be altered to reflect any unclaimed prizes. Forfeited prizes will not be distributed amongst other winners.
27. Employees and contributors of The Sunday Times, West Australian Newspapers and Channel Seven, agencies and immediate families are ineligible to enter.
28. Employees of The Sunday Times, West Australian Newspapers, Channel 7 Perth, their subsidiaries, their advertising agencies, participating newsagents & resellers of The Sunday Times, The West Australian and The Weekend West newspapers, and their immediate families are ineligible to enter. Immediate family includes spouse, defacto spouse, parent, natural or adopted child or sibling.
29. Winners will be advised by The Sunday Times by telephone or mail.
30. Entries can be posted to TimesPool, GPO Box 2970, Perth WA 6800, dropped off at Newspaper House, 50 Hasler Road, Osborne Park or placed at newsagencies that have a TimesPool Coupon Box. Locations of participating newsagencies can be found on perthnow.com.au/timespool. To

be valid, entries must be received in

accordance with clause 7. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

31. The Sunday Times shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss), or for personal injury suffered or sustained, as a result of entering this competition, the running of this competition or taking a prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
32. No responsibility is taken for late, misdirected or lost entries. In the event that coupons are unable to be collected or partially unable to be collected, or coupons processed in their entirety, this week's Game draw will be held over until the next week
