

**“WIN the Ultimate Fremantle Game Day Experience”
The West Australian Competition
Terms and Conditions**

By entering the “WIN the Ultimate Fremantle Game Day Experience” The West Australian Competition (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. STANDARD TERMS

- 1.1 Instructions on how to enter, prize details and other information contained within the promotional advertisements and point of sale materials form part of these Terms and Conditions.
- 1.2 By participating in this Competition entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

- 2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Western Australia aged 18 years of age or older.
- 2.2 Employees (and their immediate families) of Seven Network (Operations) Limited, West Australian Newspapers Limited (“Promoter”), prize suppliers and their respective associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
