

## **“WIN a share of \$8,000 in Fuel Vouchers” The West Australian Competition Terms and Conditions**

By entering the “WIN a share of \$8,000 in Fuel Vouchers” The West Australian Competition (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following Terms and Conditions:

- 1. STANDARD TERMS**
  - 1.1 Instructions on how to enter, prize details, and other information in promotional materials form part of these Terms and Conditions.
  - 1.2 By entering, you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
- 2. WHO CAN ENTER?**
  - 2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Western Australia aged 18 years of age or older.
  - 2.2 Employees (and their immediate families) of Seven Network (Operations) Limited, West Australian Newspapers Limited (“Promoter”), prize suppliers and their respective associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
  - 2.3 In clause 2.2 “Immediate Family Members” includes spouse, de facto spouse, parent, natural or adopted child or sibling.

- 3.2 To enter the competition you must:

Each daily codeword will be valid until the next entry period. For clarity, the codeword valid during registration 1 will no longer be valid when registration 1 ends. - 5.3 The Promoter will contact the Winners by email advising the Winners of their Prize within two (2) business days of the prize draw.
