**Alinta Energy Powering Local x SWM Competition
Terms and Conditions**

By entering “Alinta Energy Powering Local x SWM Competition”
 (“the Competition”), you are agreeing to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. STANDARD TERMS

1.1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

- 2.1. Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Western Australia, aged 18 years of age or older, where the Channel Seven (and affiliates) signal is received.
- 2.2. To enter this promotion, the local sports club nominated in the entry must be an amateur AFL Club. Any non-amateur or non-AFL centred clubs nominated are not valid and will not be included in the finalist judging or public vote.
- 2.3. Employees and families of the Seven Network (Operations) Limited (“the Promoter”), West Australian Newspapers Ltd (“the Promoter”), Alinta Energy (“the Sponsor”), Ansible Pty Ltd, and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
- 2.4. By submitting any entry material (including but not limited to a written response, photos and videos) that includes any person under the age of 18 years (“Minor”), the entrant warrants and agrees that:
 - 2.4.1. They are the parent or legal guardian of the Minor featured in the entry, or have obtained the express prior consent of the Minor’s parent or legal guardian to submit the entry and grant the rights set out in these Terms and Conditions;
 - 2.4.2. They have obtained all necessary consents, permissions and releases from the Minor’s parent or legal guardian (and from any other individual appearing in the entry) to submit the entry into the promotion and to permit the Promoter to use the entry as contemplated by these Terms and Conditions;
 - 2.4.3. The Minor’s parent or legal guardian has consented to the collection, use and disclosure of the Minor’s personal information (including image, likeness, voice and any other identifying material contained in the entry) by the Promoter and/or Sponsor for the purposes of administering the promotion and for promotional, marketing and publicity purposes in any media, without compensation, unless otherwise prohibited by law;
 - 2.4.4. The entry does not contain any content that is inappropriate, offensive, defamatory, unlawful or that otherwise breaches any applicable laws, regulations or third-party rights, including privacy and intellectual property rights;
 - 2.4.5. The entrant acknowledges and agrees that the Promoter may, at its discretion, request written evidence of such consents and permissions at any time, and may deem an entry invalid if such evidence is not provided upon request;

3. OVERALL COMPETITION PERIOD

- 3.1. The Competition commences on **Friday 3rd July 2026 at 6:00 AM AWST** and concludes on **Tuesday 11th August 2026 at 9:00 AM AWST** (“the Competition Period”).

4. NOMINATION PERIOD

- 4.1. The Nomination Period, during which entries may be submitted in accordance with clause 6, commences on **Friday 3rd July 2026 at 6:00 AM AWST** and concludes on **Thursday 30th July 2026 at 11:59 PM AWST** (“the Nomination Period”).

5. VOTING PERIOD

- 5.1. The Voting Period commences on **Monday 3rd August 2026 at 6:00 AM AWST** and concludes on **Tuesday 11th August 2026 at 9:00 AM AWST** (“the Voting Period”).

6. HOW TO ENTER

- 6.1. To enter the Competition entrants must:
- Visit the designated Competition page at competition.7plus.com.au/poweringlocal; and
 - Complete all required fields in the Competition entry form including but not limited to full name, address (including postcode), date of birth, a valid email address and telephone number; and
 - Provide the club name, club president name and address of their local junior AFL Club they would like to nominate; and
 - Submit a short written entry response (maximum 250 words) explaining why the nominated Local AFL Club deserves to win. Entries may (optional) include supporting photos or short videos and;
 - Tick the checkbox confirming they are available to attend the applicable Round 23 Game or Round 24 Game (as determined in accordance with clauses 6.8 and 6.9) and participate in a live broadcast on Channel Seven.
- 6.2. Entrants may enter once per nominated club. Any entrants found to have nominated the same club more than once, will have their entries deemed invalid, at the discretion of the Promoter.
- 6.3. If any entries are deemed at the Promoter's final discretion to be made via "scripting", those entries will be deemed invalid and will not be accepted.
- 6.4. In the event that an element of the prize outlined in Clause 7.2, below is, for any reason, cancelled, postponed or not available, that element(s) of the prize will be considered as forfeited and no cash alternative offer will be granted in lieu of the part of the prize. If the Winner forfeits a specified element, no cash alternative offer will be granted in lieu of the part of the Prize.
- 6.5. Each valid entry received over the duration of the Nomination Period will be entered into the corresponding Finalist judging.
- 6.6. Entrants can submit an entry anytime within the Nomination Period to be included in any Finalist judging after their entry has been submitted.
- 6.7. Entries must be received during the Nomination Period and no later than Thursday 30th July 2026 at 11:59 PM AWST to be included in the Competition.
- 6.8. At the time of writing, the exact date for the Fremantle v Adelaide AFL game (the "Round 23 Game") has not yet been confirmed, but the Winner and up to three (3) companions must be able to attend the Round 23 Game, which will take place between 14th-16th August, whilst also noting the information laid out in clause 6.9.
- 6.9. If, due to network scheduling, Seven are unable to broadcast the Round 23 Game in clause 6.8, the Winner will be required to attend the West Coast Eagles v Hawthorn AFL game (the "Round 24 Game"). The Winner understands that in accepting these Terms and Conditions, they could be required to attend either the Round 23 Game or the Round 24 Game and participate in any and all promotional activities as noted in clause 7.4.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. There will be **One (1) Major Prize Winner ("Winner")** who will win the following Prize package as detailed in the table listed in clause 7.2:

- 7.3. Total maximum Prize pool value for the Prize is **up to \$20,280.00 AUD**
- 7.4. In accepting the Prize, the Winner agrees to participate in and co-operate with all reasonable media, promotional and editorial requests, including but not limited to, being interviewed, photographed, audio/video recorded, and participating in promotional broadcasts and content relating to the promotion. This includes, without limitation:
- Live read in Saturday Breakfast, announcing each finalist and their club details

- One x 45 second live read in Weekday Breakfast announcing Winner and highlighting club
- One x 45 second live read in Saturday Breakfast, which will be a recorded interview with a representative of the Winner's nominated club with Ryan Daniels

The Winner and Finalists grant the Promoter a perpetual and non-exclusive licence to use such footage and photographs in all media worldwide and the Winner and Finalists will not be entitled to any fee for such use. Any person under the age of 18 years may only be featured in any broadcast or media material with the prior consent, written or otherwise of their parent or legal guardian. The Winner and Finalists warrant that such consent has been obtained, and the Promoter, Seven Network (Operations), any naming rights sponsor, and Ansible Pty Ltd will not be liable for any failure by the Winner and Finalists to obtain that consent.

- 7.5. Entry details remain the property of the Promoter, including any images or videos. The Promoter may use any images or videos as submitted in any entry in including, but not limited to, The West Australian print and digital platforms, promotional materials or on the Channel Seven Broadcast.
- 7.6. The Winner and Finalists agree they will not sell or otherwise provide their story and/or photographs to any media or other organisation.
- 7.7. It is a condition of accepting the Prize that the Winner must comply with all the conditions of use of the Prize and the Promoter's requirements.
- 7.8. In the event that an element of the Prize outlined above is not available for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute with a similar product of equal or greater value, subject to state regulations and the Promoter's discretion.
- 7.9. The Promoter reserves the right to close and finish the Competition early at their absolute discretion, subject to government legislation. In the event of this the Prize will be forfeited and no substitute prizes will be provided.
- 7.10. Once the winning entry has been allocated via the public vote (as outlined in clause 8) the Winner will be contacted directly via the email address listed on their competition entry form and by phone call within two (2) business days of the public vote conclusion.
- 7.11. The Winner and Finalists may be required to provide valid identification to the Promoter.
- 7.12. The Promoter may require the Winner and Finalists to sign a waiver of liability and indemnity in the form determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion.
- 7.13. The Promoter may vary these Terms and Conditions at its discretion, subject to state government legislation.
- 7.14. Any person under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult for the duration of any broadcast or media editorial requests as listed in these Terms and Conditions, that may be associated with the Prize.
- 7.15. The Prize will be awarded via EFT to the Winner directly for payment of invoices as agreed by the Winner and the Promoter. Invoices for completed work must be supplied by the Winner to Ansible Pty Ltd and the Promoter, for approval.
- 7.16. It is a condition of acceptance that, the Winner is required to send any and all invoices for work completed on the nominated club to Ansible Pty Ltd. From the total amount listed on all applicable and valid invoices, Ansible Pty Ltd will then transfer that total amount to the Winner directly via EFT. All valid invoices must be provided to Ansible Pty Ltd on or before **Monday 16th November 2026** for those funds to be included in the total Prize payment/s made to the Winner. Once the Prize funds have been received by the Winner, the Winner will then be responsible for payment of all invoices for any work completed on the nominated club. The Promoter and their associated agencies will not be responsible for payment of any invoices directly.
- 7.17. If the total invoice amount exceeds the total Prize pool, the Winner will be responsible for all remaining costs payable to the approved vendor as listed on the invoice, no additional payments will be provided by the Promoter or its agencies to cover these invoice amounts.
- 7.18. If the approved invoice/s do not meet the entire amount of the Prize, the Winner will not receive any remaining balance of the Prize value as cash and the remaining amount, if any, will be forfeited. If any funds are remaining in the Prize pool by **Monday 16th November 2026**, these funds will be forfeited in their entirety and the Winner will not be entitled to these funds.
- 7.19. If the scope of work detailed on any provided and approved invoice changes, the Promoter and its agencies will not be responsible for any additional fees or charges. These costs will be borne by the Prize Winner.
- 7.20. The Promoter, the Sponsor and Ansible Pty Ltd do not accept responsibility for any fees incurred as a result of any changes made as a result of the Prize being fulfilled and these costs will be borne by the Winner.

- 7.21. It is a condition of acceptance that the Winner and up to three (3) companions are required to attend the applicable Round 23 Game or Round 24 Game (as determined in accordance with clauses 6.8 and 6.9) and participate in a live broadcast during the Alinta Pre-Game AFL Coverage live on Channel Seven. There will be no compensation provided to the Winner or their companions for this appearance. If the Winner is not able to complete this requirement, they will forfeit the Prize in its entirety and a new Winner will be allocated as per clause 8. As mentioned in clause 6.8 and clause 6.9, the exact date of the applicable Round 23 Game or Round 24 Game will be communicated to the Winner upon notification of their Prize. The Winner and up to three (3) companions must be available to attend the Round 23 Game or the Round 24 Game (as applicable) and participate in any and all promotional activities as discussed in clause 7.4.
- 7.22. The Winner will be notified under embargo and agrees to keep confidential all information relating to their selection as the Winner, the Prize, and the Promotion. The Winner must not make any public announcement or disclosure of such information unless and until the Promoter has publicly announced the Winner or otherwise authorises disclosure in writing.
- 7.23. The Prize Winner and their companions must conduct themselves in a responsible, respectful and professional manner throughout the Prize and comply with the conditions of the Prize.
- 7.24. The Prize tickets are subject to any and all terms and conditions listed on the tickets themselves or as provided by the Promoter or their agencies.
- 7.25. The Prize tickets are not valid for any other game, date or location, other than the Round 23 Game or Round 24 Game (as applicable) specified by the Promoter upon notification of the Prize.
- 7.26. The Prize is non-transferable, non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non-replaceable and non-redeemable for cash. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the Prize.
- 7.27. The Promoter does not take responsibility for any tax consequences or imposts that arise from the receipt of the Prize. The Winner is advised that tax implications may arise from winning the Prize and they should seek independent financial advice prior to acceptance of their Prize.
- 7.28. The Winner must allow up to Six (6) months from notification for their Prize to be fulfilled due to the nature of the prize. Any queries must be directed to the Promoter.
- 7.29. The Winner will be required to provide valid identification to the Promoter upon its request. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the Prize.

8. HOW TO WIN

- 8.1. This is a game of skill; chance plays no part in determining the Winner. The judges' decision in relation to any aspect of the Competition will be final and binding on every person who enters. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the result of the judging or the public vote.
- 8.2. There will be **Three (3) Finalists (each, a "Finalist")** judged from all entries received (online) throughout the Nomination Period, until the corresponding Finalist judging as set out in the table below. For clarity, all valid entries received prior to the judging date and times listed in this clause will be included in the corresponding judging for that Finalist spot.

- 8.3. Each entrant who has entered the Competition over the Nomination Period and registered all details in accordance with clause 6 ("How To Enter") will be entered into the Competition.
- 8.4. **Three (3) Finalists** will be judged by a panel of representatives appointed by the Promoter, with the Finalists determined on the basis of the most authentic, deserving and impressive responses from all valid entries received (online) during the Nomination Period up until the dates and times stipulated in the table in clause 8.2.
- 8.5. The three (3) Finalists will then be included in the Public Voting to determine the Winner.
- 8.6. The Promoter may in its absolute discretion deem entries invalid subsequently to a Finalist being notified or a Finalist's name being announced if it is discovered that the Finalist did not enter the Competition in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. In these circumstances, an additional judging will be conducted.

9. PUBLIC VOTING

- 9.1. The three (3) Finalists will have their nominated club name displayed live during the on-air broadcast of the Alinta Energy Pre-Game Coverage as set out in the table below and on the Competition website during the period between **Monday 3rd August 2026 at 6:00 AM AWST** and **Tuesday 11th August 2026 at 9:00 AM AWST**. Any written response and any supporting photo or video media as provided in their entry may also be displayed during the on-air broadcast of the Alinta Energy Pre-Game Coverage.

- 9.2. During the Finalist announcements throughout the Competition Period, there will be on-air prompts directing viewers to the Competition website, where from Monday 3rd August 2026, members of the public will vote for the entry they consider most deserving of the Prize based on how significantly the Prize would benefit the nominated club. At the conclusion of the Voting Period, the one (1) Finalist with the most public votes will be deemed the Winner and will receive the Prize detailed in clause 7.2.
- 9.3. Each person is permitted to cast one (1) vote during the Voting Period. To submit a valid vote, voters must verify their email address as part of the voting process. Votes submitted using multiple identities, email addresses, accounts, devices, or any other method designed to circumvent this limit are prohibited and may be deemed invalid. The Promoter reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to verify the validity of votes and to disqualify any votes or participants it reasonably believes have breached this clause or otherwise attempted to manipulate the voting process.
- 9.4. In the event of a tie, the Winner will be determined by the Promoter at their discretion.
- 9.5. The Winner will be notified by the Promoter and/or Ansible Pty Ltd via e-mail and phone call within two (2) business days of the Voting Period conclusion to confirm their Prize and begin Prize fulfilment.
- 9.6. The Winner's entry and details (first initial, last name and postcode) will be announced live on **Sunday 16th August 2026 from 6:00pm** during the Alinta Energy Pre-Game Coverage of the applicable Round 23 Game or Round 24 Game.
- 9.7. All reasonable attempts will be made to contact the Winner. If the Prize remains unclaimed, unallocated or forfeited for any reason, by **12:00 PM AWST on Wednesday 12th August 2026**, the Prize will be re-allocated to the Finalist with the next highest amount of votes.
- 9.8. The Winner's (or Unclaimed Winner's if necessary) details (first initial, last name and postcode) will be published on the Competition website from **Monday 17th August 2026**.
- 9.9. The Promoter's decision is final and the Promoter will not enter into correspondence regarding the result.
- 9.10. The Promoter may in its absolute discretion deem entries invalid subsequently to a Winner being notified or a Winner's name being announced if it is discovered that the Winner did not enter the Competition in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. In these circumstances, the Prize will be re-allocated to the next valid Finalist with the next highest amount of votes.

10. NO LIABILITY

- 10.1. In the case of the intervention of any outside act, agent or event which prevents or significantly hinders the Promoter's ability to proceed with the Competition on the dates and in the manner described in these Terms and Conditions, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strike, war, act of terrorism, COVID 19, pandemic, the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions, subject to state government legislation.
- 10.2. Seven Network (Operations) Limited and their associated agencies and companies will take no responsibility for Prizes damaged or lost in transit, or late, lost or misdirected mail.
- 10.3. Seven Network (Operations) Limited and their associated agencies and companies will not be liable for any misadventure, accident, injury, loss (including but not limited to consequential loss) or claim that may occur:
- during the judging;
