

# Wahl Dirty Dogs Photo Contest 2024

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

A PURCHASE IS NOT NECESSARY TO ENTER THIS CONTEST

### DATES OF CONTEST:

Contest opens on March 18, 2024, at 12:00 a.m. Central Standard Time (CST) and closes on May 31, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. CST (the "Contest Period"). The submission period will begin on March 18, 2024, at 12:00 a.m. CST and Contestants must submit all entries no later than 11:59 p.m. CST on April 12, 2024.

### ELIGIBILITY:

This Contest is intended for residents of the United States of America only, and by entering you agree that this Contest will be subject to and governed by the laws of Wisconsin, excluding all conflict of law rules, and the forum for any dispute will be in Wisconsin in the City of Milwaukee. This Contest is being conducted by Hoffman York ("HY"), and excludes employees and personal associates, families, as well as those with whom they reside, of HY, directors, officers, representatives, and agents of HY, and Wahl, Greater Good Charities or The Animal Rescue Site (hereinafter referred to as the "Sponsors"). All entrants and winners must be 18 years of age or older.

### HOW TO ENTER:

Via the Wahl Dirty Dogs Contest Page ("The Contest Page")

(1) Visit The Contest Page located at <http://dirtydogscontest.com/>

(2) Registration: Complete the official Contest online entry form (the "Entry Form") in its entirety including: first name, last name, dog's name, dog's biography, shelter or rescue organization name, shelter or rescue organization website, and contact information. You must submit a before and after photo of the same dog.

Entries will be rejected if the required fields of the entry form (labeled with \*) are not fully completed and submitted during the Contest Period. Use of any automated system to enter is prohibited and will automatically result in disqualification.

There is no limit on entries during the submission period.

Sponsor and Contest Entities are not responsible for lost, late, mutilated, or incomplete Submissions. All Submissions (including all intellectual property rights embodied therein) shall become the exclusive property of the Sponsor and will not be returned. Sponsor has no obligation to acknowledge receipt of or to return any Submissions received.

### JUDGING:

From the close of the submission period on April 12, 2024, a panel of judges selected by Sponsors shall select ten (10) entries. Entries shall be judged on adherence to the contest's submission description and requirements.

### VOTING/WINNING:

May 6 — May 31, 2024, users may vote once daily for their favorite of the top 10, selected by Sponsors. Voting will take place on "The Contest Page" located at <http://dirtydogscontest.com>. Winners will be chosen based on votes, HY and Sponsors reserve the right to determine which votes are eligible.

The winner will be notified via email.

### GRAND PRIZE:

The shelter or rescue group must be a registered 501(c)3 nonprofit or municipality. No transfer or substitution of prize is allowed except at the sole discretion of Sponsor due to prize unavailability for any reason and only then for a prize of equal or greater value. There is no cash alternative offered, except at the sole discretion of Sponsor.

Each Grand Prize Winner will be responsible for any cost above the stated approximate retail value. Any difference between the stated approximate retail value and the actual value will not be awarded.

All eligible winners will be contacted by Sponsors at the end of the contest. The Prize will be forfeited by an eligible winner if that eligible winner cannot be contacted within forty-eight (48) hours after the Contest draw. None of the prizes awarded may be substituted and are not transferable.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS:**

If the identity of an on-line entrant is disputed, the authorized account holder of the e-mail address submitted at the time of entry will be deemed to be the entrant.
