Webinar #4: Periodic Records

Summary: More research is needed, but EHRs appear to be reporting periodic records more often than periodic assessment information is collected from clients. In some cases, submitting entities are not yet entering periodic assessment information into EHR, but periodic records are being sent by EHR regardless. It is unclear what information is included in periodic records. All EHRs are affected. Periodic records are often not representative of new periodic assessment. The most common issue, however, is that periodic records appear to be reported more frequently than assessments are given.
